

Employer Benefits

Clients in the Vocational Program possess a variety of skills and experience, allowing vocational staff to place them in positions where they can succeed. Employers are eligible for the following state and federal programs:

The Targeted Job Tax Credit Program

- A free program provided by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- Available to employers who hire an ex-offender
- Employers receive a percentage of the employee's wages for up to three years

The Federal Bonding Program

- A free program provided by the Federal Government
- Available upon hiring an ex-offender, ex-addict, or a person who is a credit risk
- Employers receive immediate compensation for any incidents of employee dishonesty or theft

Directed by the Eagleville Foundation, Eagleville Hospital and Riverside Care, Inc., are committed to providing quality care for individuals addicted to alcohol and drugs.

From its headquarters in Northwestern Montgomery County, Eagleville offers hospital and non-hospital level care to men and women in need of treatment for alcohol and drug addiction.

Eagleville Hospital is licensed in Pennsylvania for the treatment of drug and alcohol addiction, co-occurring disorders and other behavioral health problems.

Its outpatient affiliate, Riverside Care, Inc., provides a full continuum of community-based treatment programs for alcohol and drug dependent men, women and adolescents.

Eagleville staff members believe that addiction is a chronic disease caused by the interaction of biological, psychological and environmental factors. As with other chronic diseases, treatment is effective, but there is no such thing as a cure.

Services provided by the Eagleville Foundation include:

- Residential Treatment for Adults
- Adult Outpatient Treatment
- Adult Intensive Outpatient Treatment or Partial Program
- Adolescent Outpatient Treatment
- Adolescent Intensive Outpatient Treatment or Partial Program
- Adolescent Alternative Education Program

Eagleville's Vocational Program Inpatient Services

The inpatient vocational services provided by Eagleville Hospital prepare clients for re-entry into the workforce. Participants work on campus in the greenhouse, housekeeping department, with the grounds crew, in nutritional services, and as tutors in the Adult Basic Education Program.

Clients also attend vocational seminars during their stay at Eagleville. Clients receive job training and work experience along with instruction in appropriate work related behaviors and attitudes, completing job applications, interview techniques and resume preparation.

Outpatient Services

The outpatient vocational services provided by Riverside Care, Inc., consist of several components:

- An initial assessment to determine each client's work history and motivation to work
- Weekly individual appointments to actively search for employment
- Weekly group seminars to review positive work behaviors, practice interview skills and prepare a resume
- Job placement or placement in a training program
- Up to three months of follow up with each client to ensure a successful placement

Outpatient vocational services are offered to the following clients:

- Those who have completed vocational training at Eagleville Hospital
- Those who are nearing successful completion of outpatient services at Riverside Care, Inc.
- Those who are preparing for discharge from Eagleville Hospital's North Philadelphia Residential Program

Clients can be referred for a vocational interview when they are stable in their recovery.
